We have been following this legislation very closely as it is our firm conviction that unless we set up impregnable barriers as contained in the McCarran-Walters Bill, that our country will be over-run with the undesidables and the malcontents of other nations.

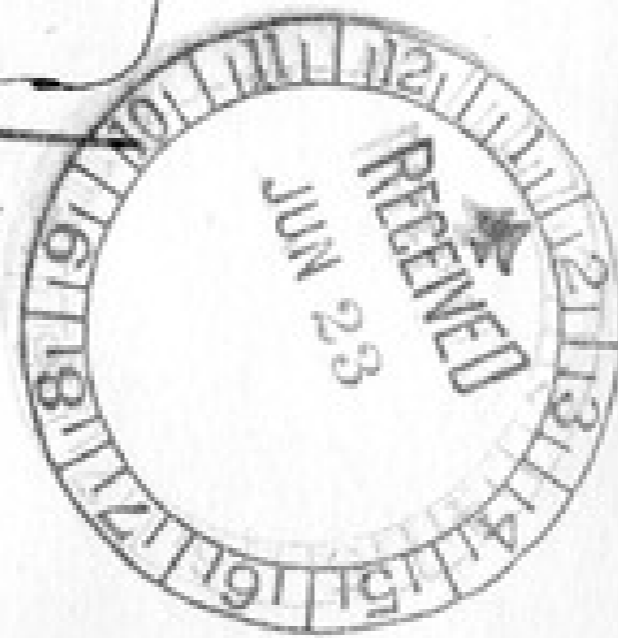
