MEMORANDUM FOR MR. MURPHY:

I attach a draft of a memorandum to the President concerning the immigration bills. This is an outgrowth of the conversation we had the other day about putting this complicated picture together in a simple way.

I would like to have your comments on this.

Perhaps it would be better if it were a memorandum from you to the President.

Incidentally, John McCormack has notified the President that Congressman Walter has promised to have hearings on the President's proposals in his sub-Committee of the House Judicial Committee on May 12. I intend to start on Monday to agitate the Displaced Persons Commission, the State Department and the CIA to get together and present a good and coordinated case.
